Housing Agreements:

- Rooms are subject to availability

- Students are responsible for all costs that may occur e.g. a refundable deposit, monthly rentals, facilities charges and utility bills
- Utilities may range from 1,500 – 4,000 Baht per month depending on consumption and property rates
- All property management e.g. payment deadlines, utility issues, deposit return and etc. are the responsibilities of the students and must be addressed directly with the property owner
