1. All fees must be paid in Thai Baht ฿. The US rates are given for comparison purposes only. Exchange rates subject to change.
2. All fees are non-refundable.
3. Fees are subject to annual inflation adjustments.
4. Should Credit Card be your preferred payment option, please also add 3% to the total of the payment for the credit card processing charges. For more info, please contact finance-ar@webster.ac.th
5. Students taking a Summer Term or joining the Quick Start are billed at half the normal semester rate.
6. A 12,000 Baht/ 375USD/ per credit hour charge applies if you register for:
 - less than 6 credits/semester (or term)
 - more than 18 credits/ semester (or 9 credits/term)Also, please note that your scholarship is not applicable in this case.
7. ESL Programs at Webster are awarded university credits and as such are priced as separate courses.

8. Fees do not include the cost of textbooks. Students should budget between 12,000-20,000 Baht (375-625USD) per year (2 semesters) for textbooks.
9. Students should budget 7,000-12,000 Baht (219-375USD) per month for living expenses. This is an average estimation and will depend on the individual's student's spending habits.
10. Immigration and Re-entry fee costs are paid by students. Please refer to www.immigration.go.th for more information.
11. Online Course Fee is 22,080 Baht (690USD) per credit hour for the academic year 2018-2019.

Refunds/ Payment Request Process

- Refunds will be only processed after receiving a request from students along with passport or WUT student ID card photocopy and Bank book photo copy with student's signature.
- Refund process takes maximum of 10 working days after receiving request from the students.
- Refunds above 200,000 will be made in 2 installments. The first 200,000 Baht will be made after receiving the refund request. The remaining will be made in 10 working days after 1st installment is transferred

If students drop or withdraw their classes

Students tuition refunds are contingent on the drop or withdrawal date.
